Program Requirements

Bachelor of Music (Honours) Requirements:

- 64 units from the BMus(Hons) List, comprising:
 - 26 units for Core Courses; and
 - 12 units for Flexible Core Courses; and
 - 10 units for Research Courses; and
 - 16 units for General Elective Courses, with no more than 10 units of level 1 courses.
