

# Bachelor of Music (Honours)/ Bachelor of Education (Secondary) 2016 Dual Degree Program Structure

**Please ensure that you read and understand the following important information about your program.**

To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. ***Please note:*** Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree.

## **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

The Bachelor of Music (Honours)/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) dual degree program prepares students to be specialist music teachers.

1. The Bachelor of Music (Honours) provides the content knowledge for teaching music in schools.
2. The Bachelor of Education (Secondary) provides the skills, knowledge and practical experience required for teacher registration and employment.

### ***Bachelor of Music (Honours) Section Requirements:***

- ❖ #48 from the BMus(Hons) List, comprising:
  - #22 for Part A; and
  - #18 from Part B, comprising the Music Learning major and a minor; and
  - #8 from Part H.

### ***Bachelor of Education (Secondary) Requirements:***

- ❖ #32 from the BEd(Sec) List, comprising:
  - #16 for Part A, including EDUC3001 and EDUC3002; and
  - #16 from Part B (the Professional Year).

Part B (the Professional Year) must commence in Semester One. You must complete all Bachelor of Music (Honours) requirements and Part A before you can commence Part B.
