

Bachelor of Music (Honours)/ Bachelor of Science 2019 Dual Degree Program Structure

Please ensure that you read and understand the following important information about your program. To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 80 units for the program.

Bachelor of Music (Honours) Requirements:

- ❖ 48 units from the BMus (Hons) List, comprising:
 - 22 units for Part A; and
 - 18 units from Part B, comprising an extended major or a major and a minor; and
 - 8 units from Part H.

Students taking the Performance major or extended major are encouraged to complete the Bachelor of Music component of the dual degree in the first four years in order to maximise development of their practical skills with their chosen instrument or the human voice.

Bachelor of Science Requirements:

- ❖ #32 from Part A and B of the BSc list including:
 - #6 from Part A (Level 1 courses) including SCIE1000 and STAT1201;
 - #14 from Part B; and
 - #12 from Part A or Part B or a combination of both.
- ❖ Students must complete a minimum of #12 of late year courses.
- ❖ Students must complete either one major (#6 advanced and #8 late year) or an extended or dual major (#10 advanced and #12 late year).
